COUNT 1 18 U.S.C. § 1546(a)

On or about January 12, 2023, in Fayette County, in the Eastern District of Kentucky,

TOMAS LEAL-PAEZ

knowingly possessed a Permanent Resident card, a document prescribed by statute and regulation for entry into and as evidence of authorized stay and employment in the United States, knowing it to be forged, counterfeited, and falsely made, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1546(a).

COUNT 2 42 U.S.C. § 408(a)(7)(C)

On or about January 12, 2023, in Fayette County, in the Eastern District of Kentucky,

TOMAS LEAL-PAEZ

knowingly sold a card that purported to be a Social Security card issued by the Commissioner of Social Security and knowingly possessed a counterfeit Social Security card with intent to sell it, all for the purpose of profit and obtaining something of value from a person, all in violation of 42 U.S.C. § 408(a)(7)(C).

COUNT 3 18 U.S.C. § 1546(a)

On or about April 12, 2023, in Madison County, in the Eastern District of Kentucky,
