Purpose

To obtain a better understanding of the current condition of homelessness in Lexington.

How was the information obtained?

What?

By one-page survey with pre-mapped routes

- 60 of 62 daytime sites
- 37 of 73 camp sites

Agency reports of individuals homeless on prior night

 "Agency" includes 43 separate Hospitals, shelters, recovery centers, schools, etc. By Whom?

 Volunteers
- Sheriff's Office
- Trained Street Voice
 Council Members

When?

Street Survey

August 30, 2023

9:00am - 11:30pm

Why?

- This count includes:
 - looking for people who live outside, in camps, in cars, shelters, & transitional housing
 - those left out of the annual HUD count (i.e. hospitals, jail, treatment centers, sober living programs, couch-surfers)
- To provide a much broader look at homelessness and housing insecurity than is currently collected in our community.




