We both agreed it would be nice if there was a more efficient detox center at the jail like what they have at the Ridge or St Joe's.

But the detained addict has to want rehab once they've detoxed. Some addicts are less willing to commit. What will it take to develop strategies to work with these people and be with them in such a way that they will see the value of being willing? That's the ultimate challenge. It seems like a huge void. We know how to work with them after they choose recovery. But not the ones who are not ready to make that decision. They are pretty much left on the street. Today I am announcing the creation of the **Opioid Abatement Commission.** Several members of the Commission are here with us today:

Chair Stephanie Raglin, Marc Woods, Tara Stanfield, John Moses, Ciera Bowman, Dale Sanders, and our Commonwealth's Attorney Kimberly Baird ... thanks to all of you for coming today, and for your service.

Commissioners, you have an important job ahead of you. You will make recommendations to the administration and Urban County Council on how to best use funds received from the **National Opioid Litigation settlement**.

These funds will come to Lexington from drug companies that helped fuel the epidemic. Like many cities and states, Lexington joined a lawsuit with multiple defendants that has resulted in an agreement that will provide significant resources. Some defendants have settled; others have declared bankruptcy. The litigation is ongoing.

Lexington has been in the trenches fighting the opioid battle for several years. We won two federal grants – a total of \$4 million – to purchase and distribute life-saving Narcan. Working with the Health Department and our first responders, we have distributed 34,000 doses.

Even so, overdose deaths continue to increase. We have had significant setbacks because of the pandemic and the isolation it produce, and because of the introduction of fentanyl, which is deadly as we all know.

We are very glad to have some new resources to help us and some expertise to help guide us.

Mayor names Opioid Abatement Commission

Mayor Linda Gorton today announced the creation of the Opioid Abatement Commission, which will make recommendations to the administration and Urban County Council on how to best use funds received from the National Opioid Litigation settlement.

"These funds present an important new opportunity for us to help our people in their battle with addiction," Mayor Linda Gorton said.

Gorton named Stephanie Raglin, an addiction and substance abuse counselor, chair of the commission. Raglin recently earned her doctorate in ministry from Asbury Theological Seminary.

The Commission will allocate funds coming to Lexington from drug companies that helped fuel the epidemic. Like many cities and states, Lexington joined a lawsuit with multiple defendants that has resulted in an agreement that will provide significant resources. Some defendants have settled; others have declared bankruptcy. The litigation is ongoing.

"We have been in the trenches fighting the opioid battle for several years," Gorton said.

In 2018 the City won a \$2 million federal grants to combat overdoses, and in 2022 won another \$2 million. Working with the Health Department and first responders, the City used the grants to purchase and distribute 34,000 individual doses of life-saving Narcan in a five-year period. In addition, 419 community trainings

were conducted in the use of the drug, and 290 people were referred for treatment and other community services.

"Despite our efforts, overdose deaths have increased over the past four years," Gorton said. "We have had setbacks because of the pandemic and the isolation it produced, and because of the introduction of fentanyl. The opioid settlement funds will help us make progress."

In addition to Raglin, the Commission includes Margaret Pisacano, Matt Webster, Connie Neal, Tara Stanfield, Laurie Brock, Ciera Bowman, Marc Woods, John Q. Moses III, Tara Stanfield, Dale Sanders, Police Chief Lawrence Weathers, County Attorney Angela Evans, and Commonwealth's Attorney Kimberly Baird.
